



ACCOMPANYING POLICY

The basis of our companion policy is the health and safety of our patients and companions.

- Whether the patient needs a companion or not is determined by the patient's doctor.
- The number of accompanying persons is limited to one person.
- The companion assists the patient's care to the extent permitted.
- The companion has the responsibility to comply with all the rules set by the hospital.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in the entire hospital building.

* Companions are allowed in some units, clinics, departments and departments. Some units, clinics, departments and departments may have their own accompanying rules; It should not be forgotten that these rules, which may differ within our general companion policy, must be followed.
